Due to the recent outbreak of 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) from Wuhan, Chiang Mai Provincial Public Health Office has issued a statement to clarify the situation as follows. In Thailand, there are currently 46 patients under investigation (PUI) and four patients are confirmed to have contracted the 2019-nCoV. In Chiang Mai, there are five patients under investigation and it is confirmed that they suffered from different types of influenza and did not have 2019-nCoV infection. Local residents and tourists in Chiang Mai can be confident in Thailand's surveillance and screening system for the 2019-nCoV. Chiang Mai Province has deployed an outbreak surveillance system and thermoscan checkpoints at the Chiang Mai International Airport. Those arriving from Wuhan will have a Health Beware Card, which contains an instruction to see a doctor and present this card along with the travel history in case of the following symptoms – fever, cough, runny nose, sore throat, shortness of breath, within 14 days after leaving Wuhan. In public and private hospitals, patients are screened for the infection and, in case of suspicion, will undergo a safe refer process and be treated in a prepared negative pressure isolation room that is of standard quality. If you have fever with respiratory symptoms such as cough, sore throat, runny nose and shortness of breath, and a travel history from Wuhan, please seek treatment at a hospital and provide a detailed history.
